Parade Rules:

- ✓ All entries are subject to approval of the Parade Manager.
- ✓ All vehicles must be decorated. All units are encouraged to follow the parade theme: "Stroll Down Memory Lane"
- ✓ All participants must obey Parade Marshals at all times.
- ✓ Coupons, candy or other items may be passed out to spectators on roadsides, hand-to-hand ONLY. For safety reasons, throwing candy or other objects into the crowd is NOT PERMITTED.
- ✓ No littering or discarding of decorations or other materials on public streets or private property, including dumpsters.
- ✓ Heritage Day Parade allows live animal entries in the parade. No special requirements are in place; however, should air temperatures be extreme at parade time, we may be required to remove certain animals from parade participation. Please be certain all animals are current on their vaccinations and are wearing appropriate tags (if applicable) and provide ample fresh water for your animal(s). Also, please be prepared to immediately collect from the parade route any feces generated by your animal(s).
- ✓ Any violation of parade rules will result in immediate disqualification from the parade.

It will be at the discretion of the chairman to turn away any entries he/she deems inappropriate.
